**Oral Communication French**

FRS1211T or FRS1210Y – 3 CREDITS, 60 HOURS

Whether you are a beginner, intermediate or advanced student, six different course levels give you an excellent choice on the road to speaking French. Using many different activities that emphasize group interaction, teachers expose students to French from a variety of angles designed to make the students express themselves effectively and accurately.

**Expression orale : avancé 3**

FRS1273

To allow non-francophone speaking students to acquire techniques to facilitate oral expression and consequently participate in situations such as presentations and discussions in a university setting.

**Written French**

FRS1222X – 3 CREDITS, 45 HOURS

Prerequisite: Intermediate level in spoken French

These courses teach you the basics of written French if you are a beginner or they greatly improve your present ability to write in French if you are an intermediate or advanced student. You learn various useful strategies for understanding written texts and essential rules for writing French clearly and accurately. You must be able to ask and answer questions in French.

## Culture and Society – Contemporary Québec

QCF1960 – 3 CREDITS, 45 HOURS

Prerequisite: Advance level in spoken French

Offered in collaboration with the Programme d'études québécoises, this course, designed for advanced students, examines the cultural and artistic evolution of Québec since 1960, from both ideological and historical viewpoints.
