Purpose

This program is funded by the Department of Canadian Heritage and administered in Student Achievement and Supports branch (SAS). Its aim is to encourage teachers of French to improve their language and pedagogical skills during July and August at a bilingual or francophone accredited postsecondary institution in Canada.

Eligibility

An applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen;
2. be a Saskatchewan resident;
3. hold a valid Saskatchewan teacher's certificate;
4. teach in French in an immersion program or fransaskois school or teach Core French.
5. be registered full-time for one of the courses approved by the Student Achievement and Supports branch, of at least 2 weeks duration between July 1 and August 31, 2012 at an accredited postsecondary institution. (see the selection proposed by the Student Achievement and Supports branch).

Amount and Award Procedure

Award recipients will receive a maximum of \$2000 for courses outside of Saskatchewan after proof of attendance is received.

The Student Achievement and Supports branch may cancel or reduce or require repayment of all or part of any award, on discovery of misrepresentation or error in the application or other information leading to the provision of the award, on receipt of a report that the student is not making satisfactory progress in his or her studies, or other grounds that the SAS considers sufficient.

Application Procedure

1. Complete all sections of the application form.
2. "Work and Education History" (section 2D); School principal as well as Superintendent or designate must sign and verify.
3. Submit photocopies of the following:
 - a) proof of Canadian citizenship (ie. birth certificate) or landed immigrant status;
 - b) social insurance card or some other document proving that you have a social insurance number;
 - c) teacher's certificate;
 - d) course description (for provincial authority approval).
4. Submit application and required documents to Director of Education or designate who will then forward it to the French Learning Program Unit. **DO NOT SEND IT TO THE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT AND SUPPORTS BRANCH.**

Deadline

- a) Award applications must be submitted to Director of Education or designate **NO LATER THAN MARCH 31, 2012**. School divisions will submit to SAS, a list of all candidates on a priority basis. All candidates will be informed in writing of their status.
- b) Application forms received after the deadline date will be placed on a waiting list on a first-come, first served basis and will be considered providing that the budget has not been fully extended.

Please note that all awards are taxable income.

Please note that any changes in program of study must be reported immediately to the Coordinator of Official Languages Programs, Student Achievement and Supports branch.
