

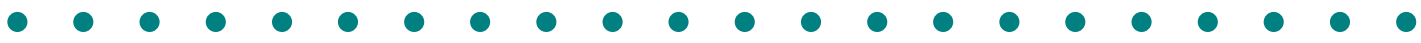

# Frequently Asked Questions

## What are the School Telecasts?

The School Telecasts are the video programs that are broadcast on television and intended to support Saskatchewan school curriculum. Educational professionals have reviewed and evaluated each program and deemed it valuable in supporting learning from Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 12. This project is managed by the Ministry of Education.

The *Saskatchewan School Telecast Schedule 2011-12* is the listing of these television programs starting on September 6, 2011 and ending on June 27, 2012.

## What channel are these programs on?

These programs are broadcast on the Saskatchewan Communications Network (SCN). This channel is available to 90% of Saskatchewan residents. Please contact your local television provider to find channel information for SCN or refer online to the station finder at <http://www.scn.ca>.

## What time are the programs on TV?

Curriculum-related content is delivered two hours of every school day. The designated broadcasting times are:

Morning: 10:30 am to 11:30 am  
Afternoon: 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm

There are no curriculum broadcasts on the days in the Schedule that are shaded and blank (i.e. school holidays).

## How do I use this Schedule?

The Schedule consists of a week-by-week layout that will assist you in your instructional planning. It includes the following information: program title, series name, and suggested subject(s) and grade level(s).

The Subject Index lists all the programs in the Telecast Schedule. For example, you can check which programs are designated as Arts Education and reference these programs in the Schedule, recording broadcast dates and times. For ease of searching for a specific broadcast, use the "Find" feature in this document (or use Ctrl+F), and type the title of the video into the Find Box located above the document on the right. Then use the arrows to the right of the box to skim through this PDF document to find broadcast times for the specified program.

## How can I get a copy of a program for classroom use?

If you are in a Saskatchewan school or school division office with a Community Net connection, you have access to ROVER. Many of the programs found in this schedule are streamed on ROVER. The site is easy to use, and programs include links to the curriculum and related resources in electronic formats.
